Taiwan, plaintiffs maintained that the Taipei Economic and Cultural Representative Office (TECRO), the Overseas Chinese Affairs Commission (OCAC), and the China Youth Corps (CYC) failed to provide adequate supervision to Peter and his peers and failed to provide adequate warnings about dangerous swimming conditions at that beach. Peter's parents filed three times, amending their complaint each time. However, in the end, the 9 <sup>th</sup> Circuit Appeals Court issued a summary judgment, dismissing the case "with prejudice," meaning that the case could not be brought again.
